

Elkins Saves Energy at City Hall and Library

The City of Elkins, Arkansas utilized its Energy
Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) to
create substantial, sustainable, and measurable
energy savings for its residents.

Elkins used EECBG funding to...

- Install a new HVAC system and LED lighting to replace older, inefficient systems
- Install insulation and siding at City Hall to prevent air from escaping
- Create a more comfortable environment at
 City Hall and the library for employees and public visitors

The project director exclaimed that "2011 was one of the hottest summers on record, yet **our energy costs for the months of June, July, August, and September were down over 50%** from the previous year thanks to our EECBG energy upgrade!"

- \$129,286 in EECBG funding
- 11 jobs created or retained
- \$3972 energy cost savings in first 9 months
- 30,348 kilowatt-hours of energy saved in first 9 months
- 61,391 pounds of CO2
 emissions estimated to be
 prevented annually
- 165 pounds of Greenhouse
 Gas emissions estimated to be prevented annually
