The City of Gentry, Arkansas utilized its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) to **create substantial, sustainable, and measurable energy savings for its residents.**

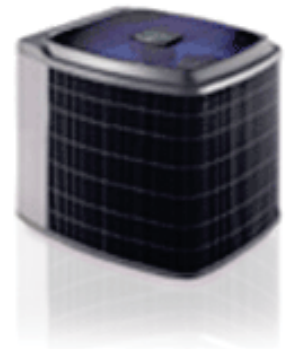
Gentry used EECBG funding to...

- **Install a new HVAC system** to replace an older, inefficient system
- **Reduce energy use of the HVAC system by an estimated 20% annually**
- **Create a more comfortable environment** for police officers, county municipal court judge staff, city council members, and the general public

Impact on Gentry, AR

- **\$40,000** in EECBG funding
- **3 jobs** created or retained
- **\$848** in estimated energy cost savings annually
- **7200 kilowatt-hours** of estimated energy saved annually
- **3 metric tons of CO2** emissions estimated to be prevented annually
