PUBLIC WORKS 2nd Qtr Report

Directors Report

Projects:

Echo Lake Boulevard Water crews trenched and installed electrical conduit along the length of Echo Lake to accommodate new lighting saving the City about \$10,000. Entergy has ordered the lights and is preparing to pull the wiring. In the fall we plan to install the sprinkler system and sod followed by landscaping.

Overlay Springhill Road Widening and Overlay Project - Street Crews have been preparing Springhill Road shoulders for the Widening Project. Their work saved the City approximately \$150,000 in materials and labor by a contractor.

16" Water Main to CAW - Completed and in service.

12" Echo Lake North Water Line - Completed and in service

Echo Lake North Road - Right of Way for the extension of Echo Lake north of Highway 5, connecting to Hilldale at Hilltop has been purchased. Design and engineering of the roadway will follow.

12" Sewer Force Main - Bids came in under estimates. Work should begin in August. The contract allows 240 days for completion.

Jump Start Initiative - Reynold's Road Improvements - Garver was selected to do the design and engineering for the Heart of Bryant Jump Start Initiative Project improvements along Reynolds Road from NW Fourth Street to SW Fourth Street. Garver is working on scope of work and the contract. Design is scheduled to begin after contracts signed, probably in August.

Master Plan for Pedestrian and Bicycle Paths, Trails and Streets - Garver is working on the plan at a cost of \$25,000. The target completion date is sometime in October.

Annual Water and Wastewater Rate Review - The review is currently underway for August delivery to the City Council.

Dewatering Project - Approval to move forward with dewatering sludge lagoon using last of ANRC funds. Going out for bid in July. Getting ready to order dewatering facility equipment in this years budget

Boone Road Water Line Replacement Project - Engineering for replacing the asbestos cement water line along Boone Road to Lea Circle is underway. Construction should begin during the winter of 2015 and lap into 2016.

STREET DEPARTMENT

The Street Department crews hauled several loads of debris from recent strong winds. Rain has hindered mowing of right-of-ways. The number of pothole repairs has gone down, but summer will likely increase the number needing repair. The Springhill Widening and Overlay Project is taking a lot of personnel time. Hopefully the project will be complete before school starts.

Wastewater Collection

Wastewater crews completed 157 in the second quarter. Crews also assisted water crews with a number of their projects using the VacCon truck to hydro excavate. We have reported a total of 3 SSO's for the second quarter of 2015, one blockage two line failures. Crews cleaned 3,165 ft. of sewer line in the second quarter.

Crews have made 9 pump station repairs, responded to 11 possible main blockages, and cleaned 15 storm drains and culverts for the Street Department.

Plant Operation

Plant operations during the second quarter have been normal with intermittent flow increases due to heavy rain. Equipment that is offline has had replacements ordered and should be back online soon depending on when technicians can be scheduled to install new units. Sludge samples taken from sludge lagoon have all passed requirements for land application and lagoon is being scheduled to be cleaned. At the end of June we started flowing stored water from the equalization basin through the treatment facility with plans to take the 1 MGD process offline for maintenance when the flow slows during the dry summer period.

Finance Department 2nd Qtr Report 2015

The second quarter of 2015 has gone well for the Finance Department. Legislative Audit continues to examine both 2013 & 2014 and the Enterprise Auditor (Water.WW) is examining 2013. We were optimistic about wrapping these up in the second quarter however we have been told by Legislative Audit the end of the 3rd quarter is more likely at this point. We have yet to be given a timeline by the Enterprise Auditor as of 7/6/15.

Any refinancing of bonds is dependent on the completion of these audits. The Finance Department continues to explore our refinancing options with the intention that upon completion of the audits the city can, and will, move forward swiftly.

The Finance Department also continues to work on several items with Springbrook including but not limited to: Fixed Asset Module Use, Accounts Receivable Module Use, Bank Reconciliation Module Issues, GASB 54 Issues, 1099s, moving from platform 7.15 to 7.16, HR using ESS, etc. The Finance Director met with Springbrook Management at the GFOA conference in late May/early June and has planned a lunch with other Arkansas Springbrook users (Conway, Maumelle, Clarksville Power and Light) at the end of July.

The Finance Department hosted a successful 1st quarter review of the Actual and Budget numbers with Council during the 2nd quarter as well as hosted a Bryant 101 class for interested citizens.

The Finance Department led a revision to the Travel Policy at the April Council meeting, presented the results from the City Surplus Sale at the May Council meeting and led the revisions on the Fire Pension plan at the June Council meeting.

Human Resources 2nd Qtr Report 2015

Benefits - Researching benefits and working alongside of department heads to offer new services beneficial to the needs of the employees; opened the leave bank.

Conferences and Seminars - Met with ARCOP/DHS regarding Employee Health and Wellness Program; Working with Fire Department to set up a committee for City of Bryant Health and Wellness Program. Health and Wellness packets have been shared with the department heads for departmental surveys and ARCOP/DHS will be scheduled to meet with the department heads. Met with DHS and Bryant High School for implementation of Volunteer program and Internship Program.

Working with Springbrook to schedule HR ESS (Employee Self Service) software and resolve issues within the software. Date of implementation still in discussion.

Position Rewrites and New Positions – Worked alongside of finance, staff attorney, departments

(Parks, Police, Code and Public Works) and the Mayor to create and rate new positions, ensure positions meet reflect accurately the employees jobs and meet all requirements for the positions and classifications.

Updated the JESAP Salary Survey Calculations to reflect 2015 at zero budget impact to the City.

HR completed the following surveys: 2015 AR Municipal League Salary Survey; 2015 AML Benefits Survey and 2015 Annual Survey of Public Employment & Payroll E-4: Municipalities, Counties, Townships (Mandated by: US Department of Commerce). In addition, HR has updated the 2014 US Department of Labor Report that will be submitted this year.

Worked with finance on educating department heads and supervisors on the new uniform clothing policy. Tracking and Tagging city items and documentation to ensure all in compliance with the IRS laws.

Worked with APERS and LOPFI regarding correction for the city.

Worked alongside, departments and Mayor regarding employee relations.

Working with Parks Events Coordinator with updates to the website.

Police Department 2nd Qtr Report

We continue to be extremely involved in public events including the serving Seniors' Lunch, Drug Take Back, Fishing with Kids at the Boys and Girls Club, and The Putting Kids Feet First Program.

Police Department was busy we answered 4,218 calls for service for the second quarter of 2015. The police and fire 911 operators took a total of 5,019 calls for service for Police, Fire, & EMS.

We filled one dispatcher position.

SRO Officers attend training at the annual National SRO conference and the State SRO Conference. We certified four officers as Child Safety Seat Technicians. We had three Officers to become certified as Law Enforcement instructors. The Police Department hosted a class for the US Attorney General's Office with over 200 in attendance.

Captain Phillip Newcomb retired with 25 years of service to the city.

With this retirement we promoted 1 Lieutenant to Captain, 1 Sergeant to Lieutenant, 1 Corporal to Sergeant, and 2 Officers to Corporal.

During the second quarter we continue to work on our Policies and Procedures to hopefully bring to council by the end of the year. We are looking into different Record retention policies that will keep us in compliance with both Federal and State laws.

Animal Control & Adoption Center 2nd Qtr Report

New Programs:

Director Tricia Power and Officer Beck Bennett attended Animal Care Expo. This year's Expo focused on the continuing work to save the lives of animals which animal control and private animal welfare agencies come into contact with on a regular basis. Alternatives to trapping and relocating nuisance wildlife and holding cats at the shelters for longer periods were the cornerstones of the Expo programs in 2015. With information gained at this year's Expo, we created an alternative to trapping program, as well as created a communal-living cat room for adult cats for adoption. Both programs actually save the City money and save more lives.

Events:

We also hosted our Spring Mutt Mixer, which attracted a large crowd of both dogs and dog-lovers from all over the area.

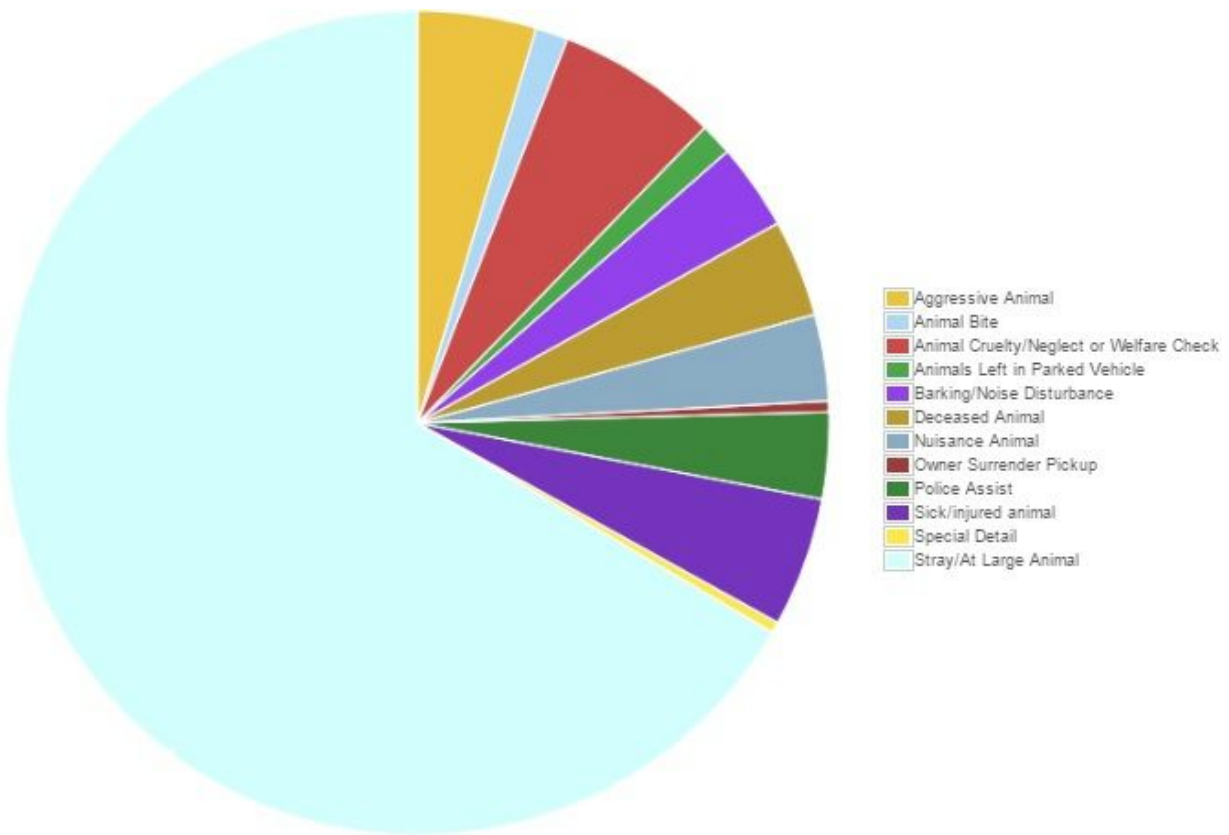

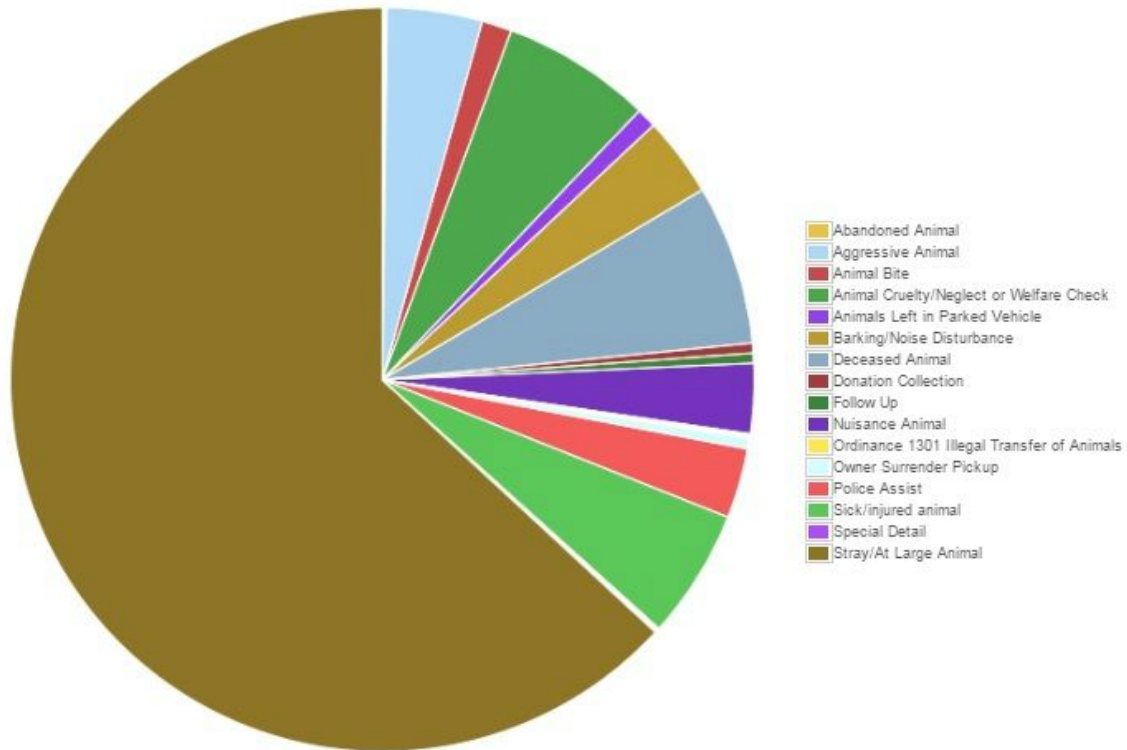

Legal Department 2nd Qtr Report

Pending litigation:

Pre-2012 Hall v. Cob. Settlement reached, minor hiccup with fence installation. Discussed alternatives and engaged fence contractor to make necessary repairs. Had flooding at park and floating fencing appeared to work. Have met with engineers and parks department regarding a long term flood mitigation management and mitigation solution.

2013- Collins v. COB 2- SJ motion filed. Awaiting response.

Eminent Domain Cases:

CoB v. Boone - Revised ordinance for condemnation approved by Council. Amended Complaint and Amended Motion for possession filed. Boone Attorney filed motion for injunction preventing taking of certain area of land. Hearing held, Court ruled in favor of Boone, granting injunction. Held a telephone conference with Metroplan, Benton Attorney, Benton Engineer, and Project Engineer regarding alternative solutions to access issues created by injunction ruling. Engineers working on design solution.

Drafted discovery to propound in cases. Will be sent early July.

Potential Litigation matters:

OpenAire and/Dayco with aquatics center. Still an open issue, with no readily available solutions.

Administrative matters:

Elected attorney issue resolved. He handles the prosecution of city cases, and I handle

all other legal matters. Ordinances amended to reflect clear division of responsibilities.

Working with Parks department on flood mitigation and management at Bishop Park, from design changes, to contract negotiations with Hurricane Lake freeboard control.

Negotiated a land exchange for City property to be sold and exchanged for property along Boone road at one of its dangerous curves in hopes of straightening out the curve to reduce accident potential.

Working with Metroplan and Benton on overlapping master street plans and connectivity along Alcoa.

Researching A&P commission, Alcohol Tax, Drink by the glass and financial impact, will draft appropriate Ordinances and discuss in July Budget meeting.

Heart of Bryant - working on code regulations - draft completed, and first reading completed. Will look to comments and revision for clarity purposes.
