Bryant Mayor Jill Dabbs has appointed Senator Doyle Webb to serve as the interim attorney for the City of Bryant.

Senator Webb is the former Chief of Staff and Legal Adviser to the late Lieutenant Governor Win Rockefeller. Webb also has been practicing law for nearly 30 years and served as the elected State Senator in Bryant, Saline and Perry Counties from 1995-2002; and a member of the Saline County Quorum Court from 1987-1992.

Senator Webb offered this comment: "I am honored to be available to serve Mayor Dabbs and the citizens of Bryant and to bring my experience for the betterment of the City."

Senator Webb stated he is not looking for long term work, but just planning to serve in the interim at the will of Mayor Dabbs.
