Special Speaker - Dr. Daniel F. Littlefield



The Bryant Historical Society will have its regular meeting on February 19th at 6:30 at the Mabel Boswell Memorial Library on Prickett Road in Bryant. Everyone is invited to come join us for some historic information on the city of Bryant. Then on Thursday the 21st at the Library at 6:30, Dr. Daniel F Littlefield will speak on The Southwest Trail and the Trail of Tears through Saline county. Dr. Littlefield holds a Phd Degree from Oklahoma University and has been on the staff of UALR since 1970. Since 1983 he has served as director of the American Native Press Archives, the world's largest archival repository of native American newspapers and periodicals. He is one of the foremost historians and educators on American Indians. In 2001 he was inducted into the Oklahoma Historians Hall of Fame.

This is one of several programs the Bryant Historical Society is bringing to the public to inform them of the city of Bryant's history and heritage. Everyone is invited and urged to attend. This will be one of the most informative programs you will hear on the American Indian in our vicinity.
