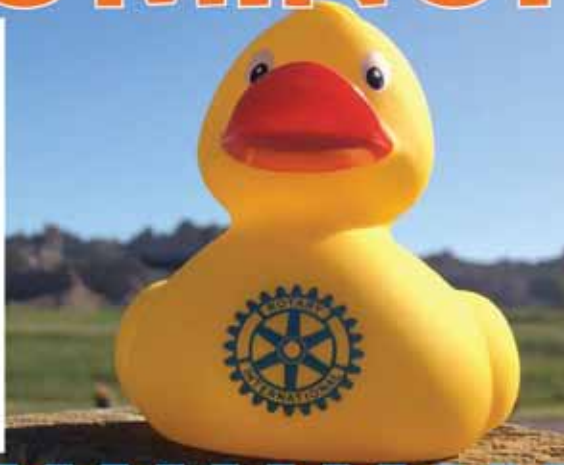

PUBLIC WORKS ANNOUNCEMENT

For sewer service billed by the City after May 1st, 2018, the amount paid by each customer shall be computed on the basis of the following schedule or rates:

- For the first 2,000 gallons of consumption per month or portion thereof - \$17.04 (minimum charge).
- All consumption in excess of 2,000 gallons - \$0.909 per 100 gallons.

For water service billed by the City after May 1st, 2018, the amount paid by each customer shall be computed on the basis of the following schedule or rates:
