STORMWATER ED'S EROSION CONTROL TIPS

Owners of property which contains creeks, streams or ditches are faced with many challenges and responsibilities such as maintenance, pollution prevention and controlling bank erosion.



Here are a few tips on addressing erosion:

- Plant trees & shrubs, especially on slopes. Trees reduce runoff by 50%
- Use ground cover plants in areas where grass will not grow.
- Avoid damaging, poisoning or removing vegetation along creeks.
- Vegetation creates strong root systems and helps hold the soil in place.
- Vegetative buffers prevent erosion and filters out trash and pollutants.
