

KEEP BRYANT BEAUTIFUL ADOPT-A STREET PROGRAM SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Acceptance of, and adherence to these safety conditions are requirement of participation in the Keep Bryant Beautiful Adopt-A-Street Program.

While cleaning your adopted area, remember SAFETY FIRST!

- One Adult must accompany every eight workers under the age of 18
- Pets will not be allowed to accompany workers for the clean up
- Inappropriate behavior during the cleanup may be cause for termination of contract
- Do not attempt to work after daylight hours. Do not attempt to work when fog or other conditions reduce visibility for drivers. Do not attempt to work when the road is icy or wet
- For the protection of all workers, appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn. Loose fitting clothes that cover the legs are recommended. Gloves are also recommended. Hard-soled shoes are required no open toe shoes or bare feet.
- Safety vests must be worn when working
- A first aid kit must be provided by the volunteers
- Avoid over exertion. Drink plenty of water, especially on warm, humid days. Volunteers must provide an adequate supply of drinking water. Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances while working is prohibited
- Stay off the roadway. Use caution when crossing the street, roadway, public facility, public parking area, park, public open spaces. Use crosswalks and signals where available
- Face oncoming traffic as you work and keep an eye on traffic. Be prepared to move quickly if necessary
- Do not attempt to remove materials that you suspect may be toxic or hazardous. Items to avoid include powders, chemicals, smelly substances, syringes or hypodermic needles, dead or wounded animals, and broken glass.
- Be alert for places where snakes may be located. Also, be alert for stinging insects and poisonous plants: i.e. Poison ivy or oak
- Participants' vehicles shall be legally located off the traveled way so as not to interfere with the free flow of traffic
