

ORDINANCE No. 2011 - 11

AN ORDINANCE TO DISPENSE WITH COMPETITIVE BIDS; TO PURCHASE SURVEILLANCE AND SECURITY SYSTEM AND MONITORING SERVICES FROM ROYAL COMMUNICATIONS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City has developed a need for security surveillance at the Bishop Park Community Center; and

WHEREAS, based on research conducted by staff, the Avigilon Surveillance System best meets the City's needs; and,

WHEREAS, based on research conducted by staff, Royal Communications is one of a few businesses offering Avigilon equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRYANT, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement to purchase the equipment and services listed in Attachment 1 hereto, for the amount quoted therein.

Section 2. Because of the need to quickly obtain said surveillance and security equipment and services, and because a local provider of these maintenance services is one of a few providers of Avigilon equipment and can deliver the required equipment in a more timely manner, the Council declares that it is impractical and unfeasible to submit this matter to a competitive bid process, and, therefore, waives competitive bidding.


Section 3. In the event any portion of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of this ordinance.


Section 4. All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. The need to further assure the safety of persons using the Community Center is crucial to protect the public health, safety and welfare; an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
