## **ORDINANCE NO. 2012-12**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRYANT, ARKANSAS ESTABLISHING A SPECIFIC BANK FUND ACCOUNT FOR THE CITY OF BRYANT FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE SPRINGHILL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT CONTRACT FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bryant approved and entered into a contract with the Springhill Fire Protection District to provide fire protection to said district; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bryant will be receiving funds from the Springhill Fire Protection District for said services; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a new specific bank fund account for receipt of said funds for the fire services provided is necessary for accurate and easy accounting of the funds paid by Springhill Fire Protection District.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYANT, SALINE COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: ESTABLISHMENT OF DESIGNATED ACCOUNT. A new specific Bank Fund Account will be established for use by the City of Bryant for projects and expenses as it relates to the City of Bryant Fire Department .

SECTION 2: DESIGNATED ACCOUNT NAME. The specific Bank Fund Account shall be designated as the Springhill Fire Protection District Funds.

SECTION 3: AUTHORIZATION OF EXPENDITURES AND USE OF ACCOUNT. Any expenditures from this account must be authorized by City of Bryant Fire Chief, and for use by the City of Bryant Fire Department.

SECTION 4: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate needs of the City of Bryant Fire Department. Therefore, an emergency is declared and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 5: GENERAL REPEALER. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6: SEVERABILITY. Should any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared or adjudged invalid or unlawful by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or judged or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the ordinance.
