RESOLUTION NO. 2017- _____

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SALINE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR BRYANT, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, certain areas of Bryant are subject to periodic flooding and other factors with the potential to cause damages to people's properties within the area; and

WHEREAS, Bryant desires to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) required that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA- approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, to assist cities and counties in meeting this requirement, Saline County, with the assistance of Central Arkansas Planning and Development District, has initiated development of a county wide, multi-jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan the county and all jurisdictions in the county, specifically the cities and school districts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRYANT, AR:

That Bryant, AR, hereby adopts those portions of the Plan relating to and protecting its jurisdictional area against all hazards; and

Appoints the Emergency Management Director to assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan be reviewed at least annually and that any needed adjustment to the Hazard Mitigation Plan be developed and presented to the governing board for consideration; and agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
